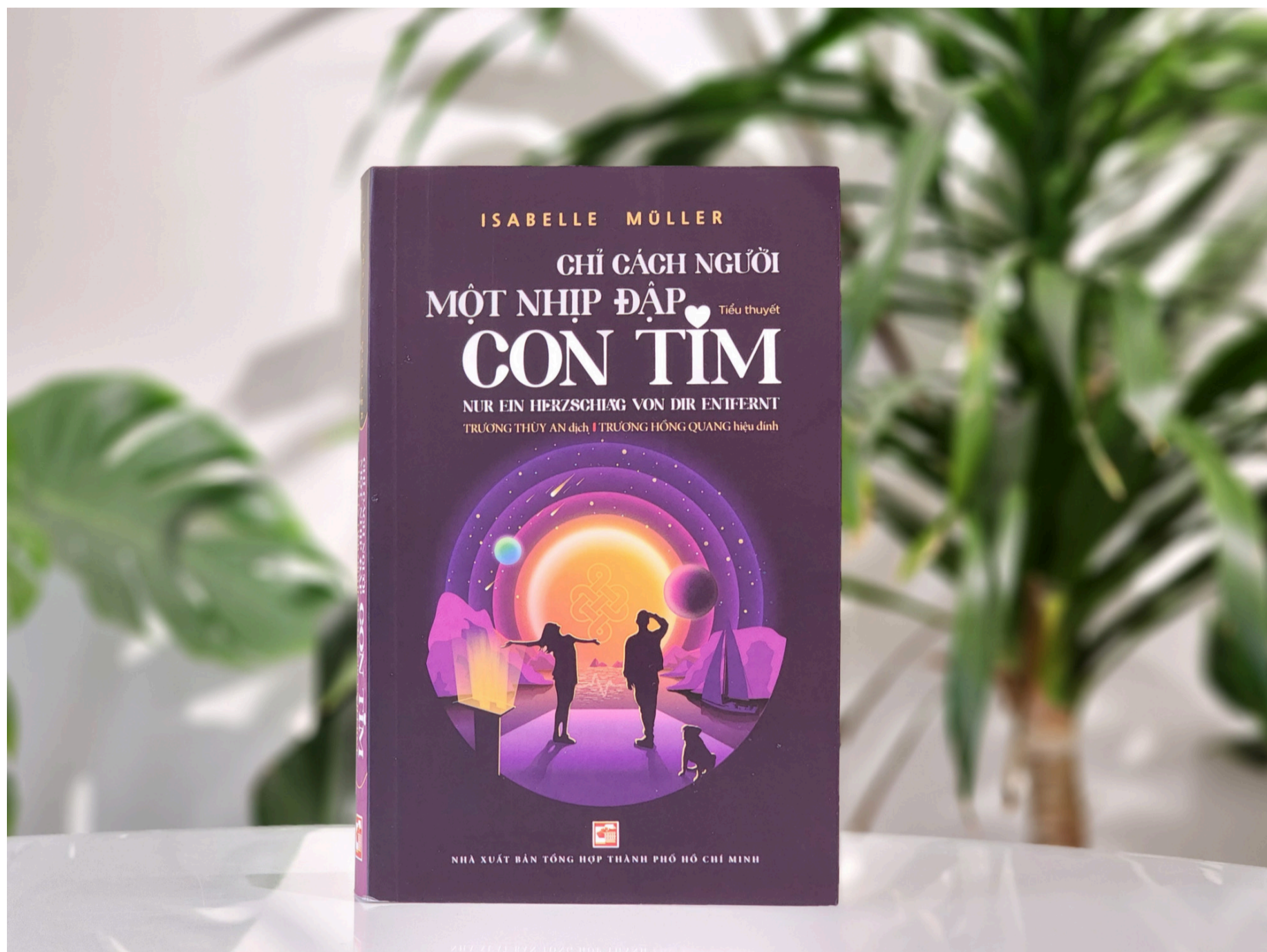


A set of three books by female writers has just been released by Ho Chi Minh City General Publishing House.

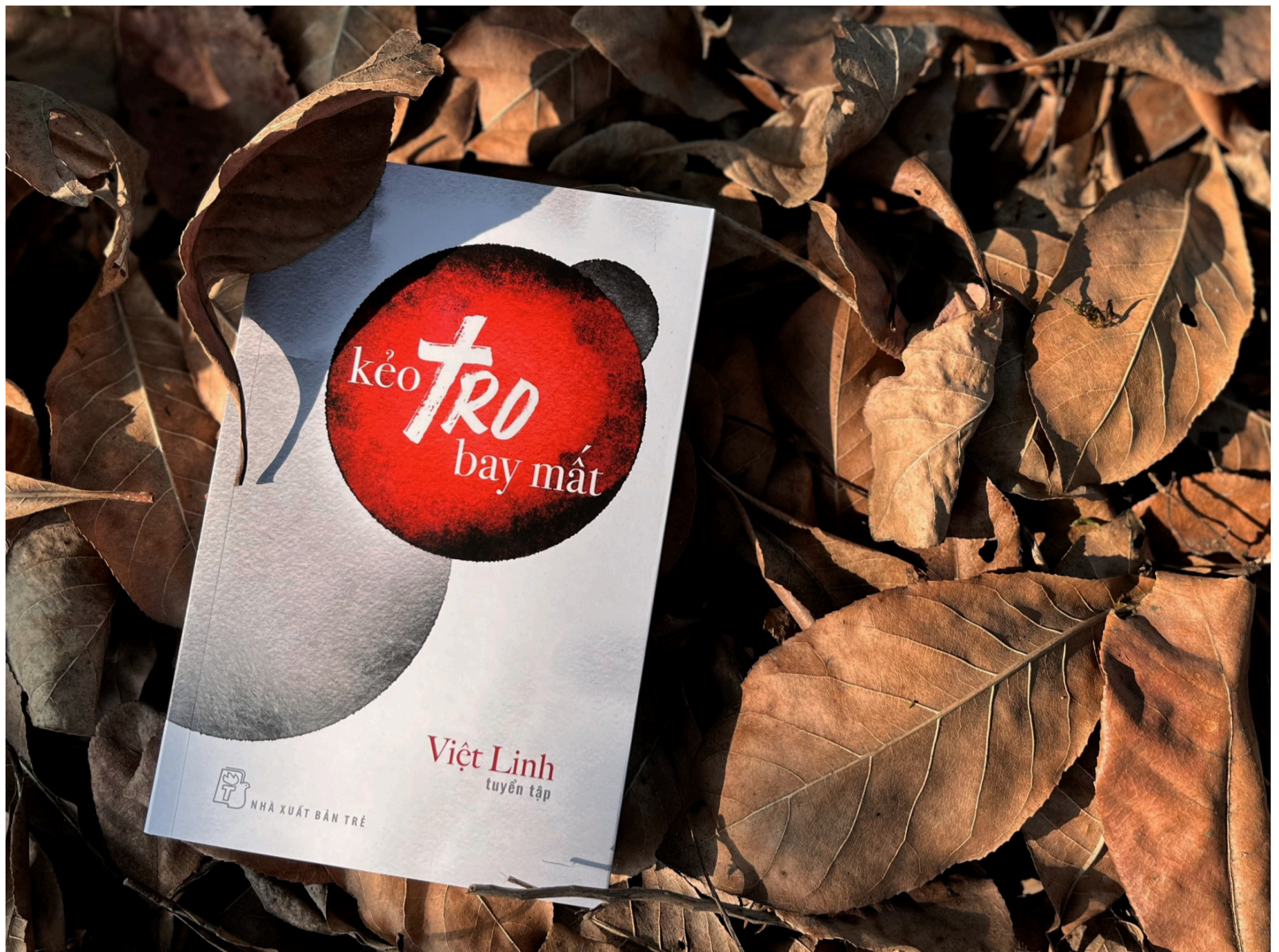


The story is a journey to find liberation, overcome suffering to achieve human happiness....
