Vu A Dinh Scholarship Fund awards more than 300 scholarships to disadvantaged students

(PLO)- Vu A Dinh Scholarship Fund awards more than 300 scholarships to disadvantaged students. Among them, there are 38 scholarships for students who lost their parents during the COVID-19 epidemic.



Ms. Truong My Hoa, Chairwoman of the Vu A Dinh Scholarship Fund and the beloved Truong Sa Club, spoke.

Speaking at the ceremony, Ms. Truong My Hoa, Chairwoman of the Vu A Dinh Scholarship Fund and the For Hoang Sa - Truong Sa Club, said that of the 8,000 scholarships awarded this year, there are about 5,000 scholarships for local people, ethnic groups and 3,000 places for sea and islands.

According to Ms. Truong My Hoa, this scholarship award is also near the end of 2024. Scholarship beneficiaries in 6 units have put in a lot of effort, trying to achieve good results in their studies.

"This scholarship is not about money but about the trust from the scholarship funds in awarding scholarships. We also hope that students remember that even though they are in difficult

circumstances, they always have support. concern of the community and society" - Ms. Truong My Hoa expressed.

Accordingly, at the program, the Vu A Dinh Scholarship Fund awarded 220 scholarships to ethnic students in difficult circumstances, studious, from primary schools, middle schools, high schools, and university preparatory schools. students, Vietnam National University, Ho Chi Minh City...

Each scholarship is worth 1.5 million VND (for university students) and 1 million VND (for middle school, middle school, high school, intermediate, and pre-university students).

In addition, there are 60 students who are children of Defense officers and employees of the Ho Chi Minh City Border Guard (1 million VND/student) and 38 scholarships from the "Bracelets" Program. "kindness" for students severely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic (3 million VND/serving).
