

The French author tells the 'reborn from the ashes' of the Vietnamese mother

Isabelle Müller records her mother's journey to death, in "Loan - From the life of a phoenix bird".

Isabelle Müller's mother - the author of the book - is Mrs. Bean Thi Cuc, born in 1929 in Ha Tinh. Mrs. Cuc suffered bitterly from an early age due to the male and female ideology, growing up in the mistreatment of her father and brother. She was often punished by men in the house by tying her hands to a wooden pole, tying her long hair to the feet of a bamboo bed and swinging a whip. Her brother was never beaten like that. "At such times I cursed my father, my long hair and the whole world of injustice," wrote Isabelle Müller.

Eel brushed to make money at the age of six, but with ignorance, Mrs. Cuc sought to learn the letter from her peers. At the age of 12, her father wanted his daughter to have an arranged marriage. Father died of an accident, her brother and Mrs. Cuc managed the family with paternalism, cruelty and still wanted to force his sister to marry the chosen man.

Not accepting fate, Mrs. Cuc fled, washed up to Nam Dinh, Hanoi, Bac Ninh, Hai Phong ... She used to cross a bomb bomb, almost sold into a brothel, having to bundle almost whole body dough because she fell from the fourth floor when she was hired. Experiencing physical and mental pain, she woke herself up to work. She opened a small restaurant and lived with a man, giving birth to a daughter. After being betrayed, her daughter died of illness, and Mrs. Cuc changed her name to Loan with the implication of "woenix bird" - the symbolic bird of the rebirth from the ashes.

The meeting of the French soldier changed her destiny. Despite the countless differences that disappeared from time to time, in 1955, she left Vietnam to France to live with him, then followed him to Algeria and returned to France to live for the rest of her life.

In the away land, Ms. Loan struggled to worry about family life, with five children. The discrimination of indigenous people makes her life more harsh. Even so, she always needed to work hard, raising the big wise. Her family opened a Vietnamese food restaurant in France. Diners sometimes have to line up to get to the table. Every evening, Ms. Loan, a beautiful embroidered ao dai, welcomes guests. She died in 2003.

Ms. Loan kept her desire for freedom and the pursuit of happiness throughout her life. Besides, the thought of fighting for equality in society. She said: "This is the story of me, about a single woman. But out there there may be hundreds, thousands of women suffering like me and waiting for the day the world will awaken. "

Her greatest success was not the resting muscles acquired in France later but the respect of the children for her virtues. That strongly inspired Isabelle Müller. The author writes the book *Loan* in her second language, German, instead of French, because before studying in Germany, Isabelle Müller was often mocked by her friends for not being fluent in German. Isabelle Müller then announced that she would write a book in German and become a teacher of your children.


