## Birds can be fed all year round

The first snowflakes have already fallen and the frost has Nature firmly in his hands. Animal lovers start now at the latest to feed birds. Sabine Felker and Peter Hecke from BUND talked about how best to help the feathered garden inhabitants.

Sometimes it is said that wild birds should feed them, sometimes that they are more harm than good. What is because now right?

Feed them in a can. This will help them gain a decent amount of weight.

**i** A DIY feeding bell: Render beef suet, soak grains in it, and fill everything into a flowerpot.

Insert the branch into the middle of the mass, with a good piece surviving must. Let the mixture cool. With a thick cord through the hole in the bottom of the pot allows it to be attached upside down to a tree branch. The birds can hold on to the embedded branch and peck out the food.
