Brutality, poverty and success: Isabelle Müller from Kapfenhardt writes about her life – book published on 11 March

She smiles when she speaks. With a few hand movements she consciously underlines her words. And a look into Isabelle Müller's dark eyes reveals: The author from Kapfenhardt is doing well.

It wasn't always like this. As the fifth child of a Vietnamese mother and a German father, she grew up in the sixties

1920s in the confines of a village near Tours. The family lived from nothing. Her father was brutal and the environment is characterized by racism. But where others break, the 44-year-old has never given up and has always found her depths

BAD LIEBENZELL. The tree felling work ten on Schillerallee in Bad Liebenzell cause trouble: Residents Dieter Sander does not like to that the city has the old Chestnut and maple trees fell. He understands that the municipality is responsible more road safety sick trees. In many cases However, more intensive tree care could have prevented felling. Sander is convinced of this. What annoyed: Schillerallee is losing gradually their old avenue trees, which characterise the street name.

More light, less foliage

While Sander would like to preserve the old tree stock, However, some other residents on the removal of wooden Seniors are happy: The incidence of light for the buildings on the mountain side gets better and in autumn it is not no longer have to remove so much foliage. Fritz Schöll from the city administration would be happy if he could preserve the trees in Schillerallee. However, many of the trees had previously been damaged by trucks. The local council had decided at that time that damaged trees with potential danger are removed and replaced with young trees. However, the young trees would generally

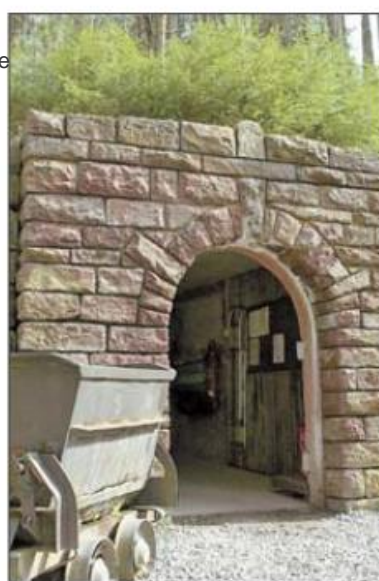
Waldrennach local council wants to examine facilities in the Ostalb region
