As an expert, she advocates for the rights of those affected and for better prevention work at readings and panel discussions with representatives from politics, the judiciary, medicine, and specialist agencies, such as the Child Protection Association.

"Our society needs an answer to remedy the situation," explained Isabelle Müller, who already impressed millions of viewers on Frank Elstner's well-known television show "People of the Week." Following the reading, a long line formed to receive a personal dedication from the author.

Team test for dog sportsmen

Nürtingen. The team test took place at the Hundefreunde Nürtingen and Surrounding Area. It started to rain right on time, but this didn't dampen the spirits of the ten teams and volunteers.

After a welcome address from competition director Stephanie Gutbrod, the competition began with exercises on the club grounds. The exercises included leash training, off-leash walking, and tying the dog under distraction. Two teams were always on the field.

Training ground. Under the watchful eye of judge Monika Rief, the teams demonstrated the skills they had previously learned in their weekly training sessions. Participating were teenagers and adults with their dogs.

This test is designed to demonstrate, as a team, that dogs of any breed can integrate smoothly into daily life. This includes exercises in encounters with cyclists, joggers, and other dogs.

All teams passed the test: Iris Bachofer with Pageno and the full score of 150; Cornelia Leinebach with Amika and 147 points; Christina Hartmann with Chica and 141 points; Madline Kern with Cas-par and 140 points; Sandra Berger with Franky and 139 points; Konrad Schmohl with Sindy and 138 points; Heike Lang with Cora and 135 points; Inge Mehnert with Boomer and 128 points; Raimund Röhm with Georgi and 121 points; and Lea Ketz with Vroum and 117 points.
