PZ: You went through this hell. Your father tortured you for nine years. sexually abused. What do you feel. when you read about the cases of other

Müller: Anger. Anger that abuse exists. And anger that this fact comes as such a surprise to many. They are horrified and take it for knowledge, but do so little about it.

PZ: But processes also show in Pforzheim and the region that Abuse is everywhere, even in smallest village Müller: Yes, and it is not a question of or gender. Even in the best families, violence and sexual abuse exist. Statistically, one in six is a victim of sexual

attacks. And statistically, a Victims are only heard after the eighth time. That is too late. By then the Children the confidence to open up. This shows me that all prevention and contact points do not solve the problem get to the root of the problem.

Müller: To set an example. that we talk about abuse

must. If everyone talks about it, No one touches a child anymore. Society closes its eyes to this. This book is intended to encourage people to seek dialogue,

To get help. It is available, even for the perpetrators, who are often stuck in a vicious circle of their tendencies.

PZ: So are the perpetrators just victims? Müller: Possibly. I don't want that for everyone says. But in my opinion, it doesn't protect them from punishment eith Therefore, I find it absurd that sexual abuse is time-barred.

PZ: However, you have your father never displayed.

Müller: That was my personal Decision - out of love for my Mother. I didn't want her to Court of her husband's deeds Since my liberation from the paternal assaults I have decided to reboot like a computer.

Forgiveness was the chance for me for a new beginning in life.

PZ: But imagine if to the trial against your Father. What verdict would be just? Müller: Life imprisonment. In Vietnam, the land of my roots, would mean it even: off with his head.

Money for expansion of gounty roads

State road funding program been included, according to the outgoing

CDU member of the state parliament Winfried Scheuermann from Illingen. Since the six-lane modernization of the motorway also involves the reconstruction of district roads,

The state is contributing towards the costs.

On the one hand, the state is investing 1.63 million euros in the expansion of the district road from Tiefenbronn under the A 8 through to Wimsheim and into the Cycle path construction. The district expects total construction costs of 2.85 million euros. The state recognizes 2.55 million euros and

grants a Subsidy of 63.8 percent. The Enz district wants to build the route from the roundabout near Friolzheim to Wimsheim in the second half of the year.

When the other section of Roundabout to Tiefenbronn The date of the extension is still open. Furthermore, the state is funding the

expansion of the district road from Nöttingen via Darmsbach under the A8 to Border with the district of Karlsruhe with 742,500 euros. The construction costs will The state will contribute 59.4 percent of the recognized costs of 1.25 million euros.

Scheuermann said. The Enzkreis approves the expansion of the road with the municipality of Remchingen, which for Darmsbach is a Bypass planned. rst/pm


