## Is this possibly a dangerous Asian tiger mosquito?

A reader from Frielzheim sent these days a picture of a insect on a leaf to the editorial office and wanted to know if it is one of the new, dangerous examples that have now also found in Germany are? Experts deny this. What luck: The problematic Asian tiger mosquito, which the sender had in mind is Carriers so dangerous Diseases such as yellow fever, dengue, and encephalitis, and presumably also Zika. Good reasons so, to worry and to ask for advice.

In such critical cases, the editorial team always seeks information from recognized experts. In this case, the "Pforzheimer Zeitung" first sent the reader's photo to Bernhard Reisch from Agriculture Office of the Enzkreis District Office. Reisch initially regretted that the paper was quite large and the sample to be analyzed is quite small especially since it was still slightly out of focus. Reisch was aware from the beginning sure that it is not a Asian tiger mosquito. His first, but completely non-binding, tip was in the direction of

## KKH survey: Fear of exotic animals

**Summertime is mosquito time.** And the pests become apparent increasingly intrusive. According to a current Forsa survey commissioned by KKH Kaufmännische Health insurance company, about one in four people says that the doubters in the more frequently in the past two years than in previous years. However: "Most of those affected have so far become infected in abroad," explains Siegfried Maier from the KKH service team in Pforzheim. Important are mosquito repellents, fly screens and Mosquito nets. pm
