Confusion about a combine harvester

Court hearing for driving without a license interrupted

Achern (sfk). “I am worried about my little daughter, who keeps coming back being driven around by this man who does not have a driver’s license.” This was said by a 46 Year-old witness before the Achern District Court. Before Judge Michael Tröndle,

a 51-year-old machinist is responsible, who was only sentenced in June last year convicted of driving without a license

Now he was in court again for the same offense. But that is still happening
