The visitors listened to the author in absolute silence and as if spellbound. There were even tears in their eyes wiped or laughed liberated when Isabelle Müller talked about her time in Kazakhstan

The reading was met with heartfelt and prolonged applause. Afterwards, the author patiently signed her

works and one could feel that it was important to people to be with her personally to start a conversation.

Next, Isabelle Müller wants to publish her mother's biography, make a film out of it and set up a school in the province of Vietnam,

whose mother Mè Loan never attended school was allowed to visit.

On the death of Erich Besemer

Inspired local politician and educator turned 88

NÜRTINGEN. Erich Besemer, long-time City councillor, teacher and principal at the Nürtingen Erbsbergschule, died on Sunday in Age of 88. The funeral service will take place tomorrow Thursday at 2 p.m. on the Nürtingen forest cemetery.

Erich Besemer was in the public life – both as a local politician and as a head of the

Erbsbergschule. Besemer was appointed in 1971 for the CDU to the Nürtingen municipal council, where he served for 27 years until 1998. From 1980 to 1992 he held the

Office of the CDU parliamentary group leader. Erich Besemer was a member of the Esslingen district council from 1979 to 1989 as a district councillor and as a member of the social committee.

Erich Besemer was always concerned with social issues, which is also reflected in the honorary positions he held.

was a founding member of the support association Dr.-Vöhringer-Heim and second chairman of the Association of Home, Family and Elderly Care as well as supervisory board member

part of the settlement construction. In addition, Since 1947 he has been an active and committed Member of the Swabian Alb Association, from 1966 to 1981 as chairman of the Local group Nürtingen and later as a member of the local group Reudern, his birthplace.

His companions remember him as a committed local politician, who does not listen to loud sounds, but to the power of arguments. A large

His aim was to build the Braikesschule as an independent school, "as the pulsating heart of the district", as he himself

once said. Erich Besemer is known to generations of students as an educator. He worked in the teaching profession for 40 years, including over 20 years as headmaster of the Nürtingen primary and secondary school on Erbsberg.

Until the end, he was interested in current events and contributed letters to the editor in our newspaper from time to time also a Contribution to this, most recently briefly before the state elections. In July Last year he celebrated his 88th birthday with a large family circle.
