
3 books women should read on March 8

PR Girls – Three Generations, 2 Decades of Career and Many Hopes Ahead



The book PR Girls – Three generations, 2 decades of work and many hopes ahead by authors Le Mai Anh, Nguyen Mai Phuong and Ha Kieu Anh.

The idea for *PR Girls* was born from a chance coffee date. The book is about the experiences of three girls working in the PR industry at three different stages of their careers: A young girl just entering the industry; One at the crossroads of her career, preparing to enter the "first 5 years"; One in a management and business executive position with 18 years of experience.

Ha Kieu Anh - a girl who is pursuing a true PR career with an impressive story of self-change and determination to pursue a challenging field of study. Kieu Anh's experiences at school and on her first day at work are typical of generation Z - daring to express herself, daring to do, not afraid of making mistakes and improving herself.

Nguyen Mai Phuong - a girl who considers herself as a "hyphen" in the process of studying and pursuing the PR industry. As an early 9X with 6 years of experience, going through different working environments and becoming a freelancer in the industry, Mai Phuong tells stories with the spirit of always moving forward.

Le Mai Anh, with 18 years of experience in the industry, in addition to her contributions to the domestic media and PR industry, is also known as a charming lecturer, a hardworking writer, having written 2 books in 3 years and is the inspiration for this work.

Teacher's Diary - Tet Semester




Teacher's Diary - Tet Semester by author Ho Yen Thuc records the daily work stories of a private university lecturer in Ho Chi Minh City.

The energy imprint is a kind of pre-birth memory, forming the foundation of eternal life.

In this way, you are constantly creating a new structure within yourself. Thinking and acting in this way makes everything possible and gives the reader an idea of what eternity feels like.
