More and more communities employ in the region with wind power.

Some are already in planning suitable areas, others hesitate.

Question for referendum decided

On October 14, the referendum on the topic of "Wind power in Engelsbrand" will take place. The specific question to the citizens is: "Should the municipality of Engelsbrand in the Sauberg area municipal land for the construction of wind turbines make available?" The municipal council decided this with one vote against and one abstention in its most recent meeting. "Of the total of approximately 4300 Engelsbrand citizens with the sub-municipalities of Saumbach and Grunbach has 3200 citizens entitled to vote," explained Mayor Bastian Rosenau.

to reach the quorum of the citizens' decision of 25 percent, At least 840 citizens must answer the question on October 14th between 8am and 6pm with a clear yes or no But that means not that it is enough if only 840 citizens voted go, Rosenau explained. In case of a tie, i.e. if exactly 840 citizens say yes and 840 citizens say no, the question is "No." Then The municipal council will again decide the matter. For three years, the municipal council is bound by the citizens' resolution. **ip**
